Our small group ministry is a vital part of life here at Bethel. Every 2nd and 4th Sunday evening of the month are reserved for small groups to meet (although some groups meet at other times or days of the week). Our groups are as unique as the people in them. There are groups that prefer DVD style studies, while some that prefer more in-depth, verse by verse Bible study, and some that do drama or go out and serve the community.

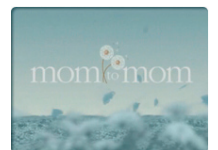
